

J525 School (Stretcher) Bench Assembly Directions

When first assembling this piano bench, you should only hand tighten the nuts on each leg until you have all four legs and stretchers installed.



Lay Out Legs as Shown in a Pair

Place One Pair at Each End of Bench

Attaching legs to piano bench:

- To attach leg, put bolt sticking out of leg through hole in corner bracket in each corner of piano bench.
- Next, put lock washer in place. Then thread hex nut on.

Hardware included:

DO NOT TIGHTEN LEGS BEYOND FINGER TIGHT AT THIS POINT

- Attach short stretcher pieces by hand tightening into place.
- Attach long stretcher piece by hand tightening into place.

To Complete Assembly of Piano Bench:

- When all legs and stretcher pieces are attached, place bench on flat surface, to ensure legs are even and bench is level. If they are not, you may have to loosen nut on the leg, to allow leg and frame to level itself. (Gravity will do the work).
- After all legs are level, tighten all legs and stretchers with a wrench -- making sure not to strip the nut by over-tightening. NOTE: It is a good idea to recheck that the nuts are tight every few months and re-tighten if necessary.
